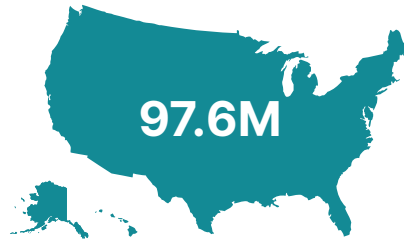


# The Staggering Costs of Diabetes

The total cost of

**\$412.9 billion.**



Spending on insulin has  
**tripled**  
between 2012 and 2022.

than those without diabetes.
