NATIONAL SURVEY RESULTS

Health Care Costs

1 in 3

Respondents said health care costs are **not** affordable

- **Nearly 1/3** of respondents reported they **rationed, skipped** or **delayed** medication or treatment in the last year due to **cost** at least sometimes.

Impact of Obesity



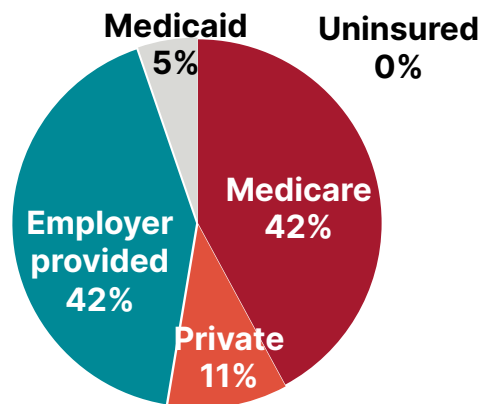
58%

Impact of Health Insurance

- High overall health insurance costs are a major factor in job change decisions
- Insufficient coverage for chronic conditions impacts job change decisions
